Vision Statement

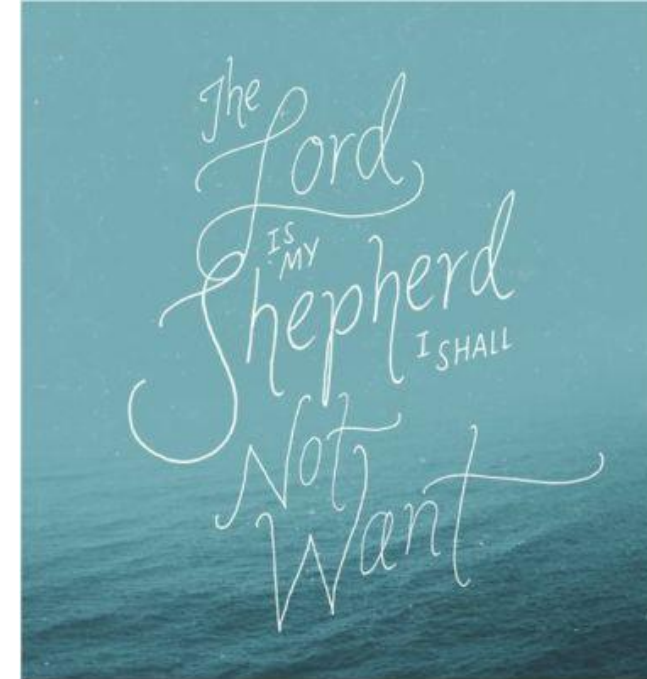
